

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 FOR 2008

**A LOCAL LAW FOR CODES ENFORCEMENT
OFFICER RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF REMSEN, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Authority

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the authority of Section 10 of the New York Municipal Home Rule Law authorizing town to adopt a local law which may amend or supersede any provisions of the Town Law in relation to the property, affairs or government of the town or in relation to any of the other enumerated subject matters set forth therein unless there is a state legislative restriction on such amendment or supersession.

SECTION 2. Eligibility of Town Codes Enforcement Officer

Section 23 of the New York Town Law is hereby amended and superseded in its application to the Town of Remsen to provide that the Town Codes Enforcement Officer of the Town of Remsen at the time of his/her appointment and throughout his/her term of office need not be an elector of the Town of Remsen, provided such person is a resident of Oneida County or an adjoining County located in the State of New York.

SECTION 3. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately.
